## Keynote Speaker: Fr. Michael Perry, OFM

Fr. Perry received his degree in philosophy and history in 1977, and completed his Ph.D. studies in religious anthropology at the Centre of West African Studies, University of Birmingham in England. Fr. Perry has served as a missionary pastor, teacher, seminary rector, director of development and researcher in the Democratic Republic of

Congo (formerly Zaire) for nearly 10 years. He is a member of the Franciscan Province of the Sacred Heart, and beginning in September 2007, he will assume a new position with Catholic Relief Services in Baltimore, Md., as a senior technical adviser for Peacebuilding.
